Lighthouses were built with the purpose of enabling ship captains to navigate into safe harbors. While each individual lighthouse has its own unique structure varying in size, color, style, and shape, all lighthouses have one main objective—that of shining a bright light that makes it possible for ships/sailors to be guided to shore safely. A lighthouse is most useful and appreciated when, in the darkness of night, only its light can be seen—not the structure itself.



When Jesus sent out His disciples, He called them "...the light of the world." (Matthew 5:14)
He also pointed out that their mission was not to draw attention to themselves but to do good works that would cause people to acknowledge God's goodness and glorify Him. Jesus said that just as the lighthouse's purpose is to give light, we are also to let our light shine. (Matthew 5:15-16) We are most effective when we shine brightly in the darkness guiding people to find safe harbor in Christ.

The Building Papua New Guinea Project continues to grow and expand. I was blessed and thrilled to deliver \$15,000 to Pastor Tau for the continuation of the building project. This amount will be used to purchase and install doors, windows, insulation, and drywall. Thus far, the Lord has provided a total of

\$30,000 for this building project with this latest \$15,000 being the second amount given to this work. I am praying to raise another \$20,000 by the end of this year to continue the progress of the building project as Christian school and Bible institute classrooms as well as a health clinic to reach the community are built. Following on the back of this letter are several photos of the building progress and other photos of teaching, preaching, and encouraging the people there.


