Shortly after Evangelist D.L. Moody (1837-1899) came to faith in Christ, he resolved not to let a day pass without sharing God's good news with at least one individual. On busy days, he would sometimes forget his resolution until late at night. On one particular night, he was in bed before remembering his pledge. Purposely, not to let a day go by without telling the Good News to someone, he stepped outside. It was raining heavily. "No one will be out in this pouring rain," Moody thought. Just then, he saw a man walking down the street. Rushing over to the man,



Moody asked to stand under his umbrella to avoid the rain. When granted permission, he asked the man, "Have you any shelter in the time of storm? Could I tell you about Jesus?"

Dwight L. Moody exemplified a readiness to share how God saves us from the consequences of sins. He obeyed God's instructions to the Israelites to proclaim His name and "declare his doings among the people..." (Isaiah 12:4). Not only were God's people to "...declare his doings among the people...," but they were also to share how He had "...become [their] salvation" (Isaiah 12:2). Now, centuries later, our call still remains to tell the wonders of Jesus becoming a man, dying on the cross, and rising again to save us from death and everlasting punishment.
